# YORKSHIRE DALES



## Walk: Aysgarth Falls

North Yorkshire DL8 3TH

Explore all North Yorkshire has to offer with a beautiful walk to visit the spectacular waterfalls of the River Ure.

The National Park Centre has plenty of parking available and is a great starting point for the circular walk which takes you into St Joseph's Wood to begin with and then out into the open countryside. The walk then descends down to the river providing some great vantage points for viewing the falls.



## Venue: Berry's Farm Shop

North Yorkshire DL8 4UH

Just 2.7 miles down the road from Aysgarth Falls is this beautiful cafe, offering visitors a wide range of seasonal, fresh and local food.

Their outside patio area and peach house are both dog-friendly areas where you can treat yourself to a slice of delicious homemade cake while enjoying the day with your dog.

Tuesday - Sunday 9:30 am to 3 pm





## Attraction: Yorkshire Dales

### North and West Yorkshire

The Yorkshire Dales is an upland area of the Pennines in Yorkshire home to beautiful scenery and landscapes, castles, abbeys and a peaceful atmosphere.

Most of the walks are dog friendly (apart from the boardwalk on the National Nature Reserve at Malham Tarn) but dogs must be kept on a lead to help reduce the chance of your pup disturbing wildlife.

Some Nearby feature locations that you can find in the K9 App include Bolton Castle, Aysgarth Falls, Edwardian Rock Garden and Cauldron Falls.

## Walk: Fraisthorpe Beach

Bridlington YO15 3QU

A beautiful sandy beach that is dog friendly all year round. The beach is used by a mixture of people from families, dog walkers, horse-riders and water sports enthusiasts. There are toilets next to the car park as well as The Cow Shed Cafe for refreshments.

Please be warned there is an electronic parking system in place so please ensure you get a ticket to avoid a fine.



## Venue: The Cow Shed

Bridlington YO15 3QU

Conveniently located at the entrance to the beach is the fantastic Cow Shed. This rustic but contemporary dog-friendly cafe is the perfect place to visit for some high-quality home cooked food using local suppliers and caters for vegetarians and vegans.

It is advised to make a booking especially at the weekends where it can get busy. There's also a takeaway menu available.

**Opening hours:** Wednesday to Sunday from 9:30 am to 4:00 pm





## Attraction: Sewerby Hall & Gardens

Bridlington YO15 1EA

If you still have some energy after your adventures on the beach, why not hop in the car and visit Sewerby Hall and Gardens which is located just the other side of Bridlington seafront. They offer something for everyone from the magnificent gardens and zoo to the heritage of the Georgian country house.

Dogs are welcome but must always remain on leads. Only assistance Dogs are allowed in the zoo, house, children's adventure playground, Stables Gift Shop, Orangery and Clock Tower Cafe. There is a section in the cafe where all dogs are permitted.

Land Train runs every half an hour from 10.30 am until 4.30 pm (subject to weather conditions and seasonal variations). With disabled access and friendly drivers, this service rounds off a perfect day at Sewerby Hall and Gardens for both young and old visitors alike.

# PEAK DISTRICT



## Walk: High Tor

Matlock DE4 3DH

Famous for its diverse and breathtaking landscapes, the Peak District is a fantastic place to visit with the family.

Take a stunning walk through a heavily wooded area up to a summit with excellent views of the nearby Matlock Bath and Heights of Abraham on the hill opposite!

This walk can get a little steep and the summit has some steep edges so make sure to be careful with your dog. Luckily there are plenty of areas where off-lead is safe!



## Venue: The Duke Of Wellington

Matlock DE4 3GX

If all that walking has built up an appetite, this dog-friendly hotel and pub is a stone's throw from High Tor and Heights Of Abraham making it the perfect lunch or dinner stop after your adventures!

Built in 1866 the 'Duke' has all the character and charm of a traditional country inn, built in Derbyshire limestone with slate roofs, roaring log fires and gardens.

The menu is traditional with a big focus on traditional pub favourites and there's a doggy menu with the best produce for your pup!

## Attraction: Heights of Abraham

Matlock DE4 3NT

Give your dog an experience to remember and fly them up to the Heights of Abraham in a cable car! Dogs travel for free on the cable cars and are very welcome at the summit. The Heights is a 60-acre hilltop estate full of woodland walks, heritage trails and fun things to see and do.

Dogs are allowed in all areas of the estate except for the underground caverns as there's lots of small holes they may run into if they get scared!



## Attraction: Peak Rail

Matlock DE4 3NA

Peak Rail provide steam train rides for tourists and visitors to both the Peak District and the Derbyshire Dales. Based in beautiful Derbyshire Peak District.

Dogs can travel on all trains free of charge. Peak Rail can offer seating in compartments which have doors thus giving dogs a more secure journey. Also, there are lovely riverside walks adjoining Peak Rail which are ideal for walking your dog.

## Walk: Borrans Park

Ambleside LA22 0HJ

The Lake District is always a firm favourite for families and dog owners.

Borrans Park has amazing views of Lake Windermere and is easily reached.

This large grassed area is one of the few parks in the area therefore it is great to let the dogs have some play time and run off some energy. It has picnic tables and direct access to the Lake.



## Venue: The Wateredge Inn

Ambleside LA22 0EP

Really close to Borrans Park is "The Wateredge Inn" where dogs are welcome inside both the dining and bar areas as well as the inn's outdoor spaces.

Covering over an acre of private grounds with direct lake and shore access, there's plenty of space for everyone to spread out and relax while taking in the views of Windermere.

## Walk: Queens Park

### Bowness-on-Windermere

Our second walk of choice is the hidden gem Queens Park. For tourists this park is not really known about and is slightly off the beaten track, however it is a super find for dog owners and dogs that need a break from all the tourists in the town centre.

This large grassed area is not fenced and backs on to local people's houses however it is great to let the dogs have some play time and run off some energy.

They are a family friendly venue, and welcome children of all ages having a plethora of games to keep the little ones entertained for hours. The community cafe is dog-friendly inside and out!


